The aquatic activities include advice on individual swim technique, training for Galas, water therapy and pool games. They also assist with advice and guidance if necessary to the carer/parent/partner to aid the swimmer.</b> <b>For the more able and independent swimmer who attends the swim session it can provide respite for the carer/parent/partner.</b>  <b>This year due to end of COVID restrictions the pool was open all year.</b>  <b>The Trustees considered these activities met the Clubs Charitable objectives.</b>  <b>We monitor and review our services every year.</b>  <b>We ensure our funds and donations meet the aims and objectives we requested them for.</b>

This has enabled us to provide a semi-structured approach to the sessions.</b></p> <p><b>We also provide parent/carer respite.</b></p> <p><b>This year due to fallout from COVID there has not been the opportunity to compete in Galas.</b></p> <p><b>The website is regularly updated with the Club's activities, future events, policies and news. The Club also has a Facebook page.</b></p> <p><b>The social activities enable our disabled members to access the local community safely and feel less isolated. This year many social events were organised including a Spring social, Panto trip, cream teas and our Xmas party.</b></p> <p><b>All the activities of the Club aim to increase the confidence, health and well-being and self-esteem of our members.</b></p>
